3/25 Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 2 December 2024

The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting were agreed by those present and signed by the Chairman.

4/25 Matters Arising

There were no matters arising.

5/25 Planning (2021-24 Planning applications/decisions are at Appendix 1)

a) **Applications**

24/03263/VRC | Variation of condition 2i)f (biodiversity net gain report) relating to application 22/03098/APP (allowed on appeal 23/00079/REF) (Change of use of land for the creation of 4no Gypsy/Traveller Pitches for residential use, including the siting of 4no mobile home, 4no touring caravan and the erection of a dayroom (Retrospective) | Land Adjacent To Lawn Hill Edgcott Buckinghamshire.

Confirmation that the travellers are paying Berks, Bucks and Oxfordshire Wildlife Trust (BBOWT) £42,200 excl VAT to achieve a biodiversity net gain on land at Piddington Road, Ludgershall to offset biodiversity loss at Edgcott is disappointing and it was confirmed that this is within the planning policy framework.

The Development Management, Planning, Growth & Sustainability has confirmed that they will not be commenting on the drainage issues.

It also was noted that there still are outstanding conditions, one of which is the access.

Action: Clerk to notify Unitary Cllr Angela Macpherson.

b) **24/03735/APP** | Erection of 2 dwellings | Yew Tree Farm Grendon Road Edgcott Buckinghamshire HP18 0TN

The Parish Council noted that it was probably outside the curtilage of the village.

It was noted that the Highways Report had recommended the refusal of this application due to the likely increase in traffic.

Action: Clerk:

- to add to the Bucks Planning Portal the Parish Council's comment.
- Write to the Planning Officer expressing the council's disbelief that the Highways Officer has
 recommended refusal of this planning application because of the increase in traffic which is
 negligible compared to the increase in traffic from the proposed MEGA prison, HS2 and EWR.

c) Appeals

Ministry of Justice Appeal (MoJ) against Buckinghamshire Council: Ref T22/00125/REF

The Parish Council had sent a letter to the CEO of Thames Water regarding its concerns with the drainage at the new prison.

Thames Water's response regarding the sewage works in Grendon Underwood and Marsh Gibbon has been unsatisfactory and confirmed that they are still gathering the information the Parish Council has requested. [Note: it was agreed that correspondence with Thames Water could be copied to Marsh Gibbon Parish Council.]

Action: Parish Council to compile questions/answers and copy to Greg Smith MP for his support.

MoJ have confirmed that they are carrying out archeology surveys. Bucks Council recommend that Conditions 14 and 15 are not discharged until archeology works are completed and reports supplied. MoJ have confirmed the next working group meeting will be held on Friday 17 January 2025 via ZOOM.

d) The following application was noted:

24/01994/APP | Householder application for removal of existing oil boiler and external oil storage fuel tank and installation of an air source heat pump and installation of a solar array to detached garage | Rectory Barn Church Lane Edgcott Buckinghamshire HP18 0TU. Refused due to the proposed solar panels spoiling the view from nearby listed buildings.

6/25 Major Local Infrastructure projects

a) Rosefield Solar Farm

No updates were available.

b) National Grid Sub-Station Enlargement

No updates were available.

c) Statera BESS

23/03875/APP: Statera Energy Development of a battery energy storage system (BESS), connected directly to the National Grid with associated infrastructure including access, drainage, and landscaping at Rookery Farm, Granborough.

It was noted that this application was refused at the Strategic Site Meeting on 19 December. It was not known if Statera would appeal.

d) Statkraft

A proposal from Statkraft for "a new Greener Grid Park near East Claydon substation" had been issued. This will be adjacent to the Statera application at Tuckey Farm.

No updates were available.

7/25 Finance

a) Payment and Receipts

Payments of accounts and receipts at **Appendix 2** were noted.

b) Electronic Banking

Clerk is looking into setting up electronic banking.

c) 2025-26 Budget and Precept

It was agreed not to increase the precept but to leave it at £10,750.

Action: Clerk to submit request to Bucks Council.

8/25 Village Hall

9/25 Highways and footways (including public footpaths)

a) Roads and Footpaths

None of the issues raised by Chair and Cllr Hawes at the meeting with the Local Area Technician (LAT) had been addressed.

Action: Clerk to write to Bucks Council with a list of the issues raised.

b) Air Quality

The Parish Council has not been notified whether it has been included in this year's air quality surveys.

Action: Clerk to investigate carrying out our own air quality survey.

10/25 Speedwatch

The Nationwide 20's Plenty campaign is still running and councillors noted that the Ward Councillor from Wing still is actively trying to get 20mph limits in Bucks.
