Cllr Hawes raised the following issues regarding the closure of Lawn Hill from Edgcott to Quainton:

- Light goods vehicles and HGVs travelling to and from the compound that adjoins the bridge that is to be replaced continue to use the road.
- EKFB/HS2 staff are ignoring the road closed signs and using the road to access the compound.
- Aggregate HGV's are also using this route.

Cllr Hawes stopped one of the drivers who said that he had been directed to use this route and specifically told not to use the internal site access road or haul roads that could take him to the compound from the A41 without travelling through Edgcott.

Action: The member of the pubic present agreed to write to HS2 to emphasise that the vehicles should not be using Lawn Hill and to emphasise that they should be using the access from Fleet Marston.
