Open Forum:

Chair welcomed Cllr Fealey to the meeting. Cllr Fealey reported on the following:

Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace (SANG)

The following is an extract from Bucks Council's website relating to SANG (https://www.buckinghamshire.gov.uk/planning-and-building-control/building-or-improving-your-property/chiltern-beechwoods-special-area-of-conservation-faqs/#chiltern-beechwoods-sac-mitigation-strategy) Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace (SANG) is the name given to arrangements for the addition of recreational space that allows residents of new homes to avoid additional ecological disturbance to Special Areas of Conservation.

Kingsbrook Meadows

A Strategic SANG, Kingsbrook Meadows at Aylesbury, has now been approved and allows us to start reviewing applications which have requested and would qualify for mitigation using SANG credit from this SANG.

The applications that qualify include either:

- applications for 9 or less dwellings within the 12.6km Zone of Influence
- applications for 10 or more dwellings within a 5km catchment area of the Kingsbrook Meadow SANG
- Planning case officers will contact applicants that qualify for credit allocations to the approved SANG at Kingsbrook Meadows. The SANG is to be delivered in 3 phases
- The consultation on the **Bucks Draft Local Plan** had closed. Chair noted that the questionnaire had not been user friendly and that as some of the content was now out of date, the Parish Council had not responded to the questionnaire.
- A VIP contact telephone number is available for Parish Councils.
- A big push is being made to rename Parish Councils to Community Councils to encourage younger people to become councillors.
- **Helping Hands** is available, which includes financial help and food banks. Food banks are available in Grendon Underwood, Twyford and Steeple Claydon. Any help can be received anonymously.
- Funding and training is available for Carers.
- Warm Room meeting places are available.

Chair mentioned that the following had been approved: 25/02292/ADP - HM Prison Grendon - Submission of Reserved Matters (appearance and landscaping) pursuant to Outline Planning Permission 21/02851/AOP

UC Fealey queried this as he had not been informed.

Following a lengthy discussion UC Fealey agreed that he would assist the Parish Council in planning applications for Conditions and that he would be willing to Call In any of these applications from the MoJ if necessary.

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Repositioning of the bus shelter at the entrance to Springhill and the issues of flooding were highlighted. 6.35pm UC Cllr Fealey left the meeting.

153/25 Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 22 September 2025

a) Applications

24/03263/VRC | Variation of condition 2i)f (biodiversity net gain report) relating to application 22/03098/APP (allowed on appeal 23/00079/REF) (Change of use of land for the creation of 4no Gypsy/Traveller Pitches for residential use, including the siting of 4no mobile home, 4no touring caravan and the erection of a dayroom (Retrospective) | Land Adjacent To Lawn Hill Edgcott Buckinghamshire.

This condition has now been 'satisfied'.

Applications to satisfy other Conditions have not been submitted except for one outstanding application in respect of the Condition regarding drainage, lighting and surfaces finishes.

- b) Appeals
- i) Ministry of Justice (MoJ) Appeal against Buckinghamshire Council: Ref T22/00125/REF Appearance and Landscaping (approved). See note above.
- The Joint Working Group of Edgcott and Grendon Underwood PCs met with the Planning Officer and Highways Officer on 29 September 2025. Also in attendance were Greg Smith MP and his PA together with UC Fealey, UC Mahon and the Chair of Gawcott and Lenborough PC. The Bucks Council representatives were informed of the necessary changes required to the CTMP but would not commit to any changes at the meeting. However, it is encouraging that following on from this meeting the Highways Officer has sent a written objection to the Planning Officer which appears to cover all of our concerns.
- Following a meeting with the MoJ on 13 October 2025, it was noted that: The MOJ are considering producing two CTMPs (possibly for the initial phase and construction phase) which has been queried. The MoJ will let the Working Group have sight of their draft CTMPs. The MoJ and Thames Water accept that the local foul drainage system does not have the capacity to cope with the new prison and Thames Water has been given 30 months to produce a plan to resolve the issue. In the meantime, it was noted that the MoJ will use bowsers to bring water onto the site and dispose of sewage if necessary during construction.
- MoJ is willing to contribute towards funding for **traffic calming** (traffic lights or roundabout) at the junction of the Broadway and the A41 depending on cost.
- An application has recently been submitted by the MoJ for a non-material change to the surface water drainage condition which has been queried.

156/25 Major Local Infrastructure projects

25/01297/APP | Construction of a greener grid park comprising energy storage and grid balancing equipment and associated infrastructure including access, drainage, landscaping and other incidental works | Land North Of East Claydon Substation East Claydon Road East Claydon Buckinghamshire. No updates were available.

25/01865/APP | Erection of a solar farm and creation of new vehicular access, new footpath, substation compound, customer substation, inverters, CCTV Tower, storage containers, perimeter fencing, car parking and associated ancillary development. Wings Farm, Marston Road, Granborough Buckinghamshire MK18 3JX. No updates were available.

Rosefield Solar Farm

It was noted that the Development Consent Order (DCO) has been submitted. This stage of the DCO process is led by the Planning Inspectorate.

The Application is now at the pre-examination stage. During this period, anyone can register to participate and be kept informed about the progress of the application by becoming an 'Interested Party'. This includes the opportunity to submit your views about the application in writing (known as a 'Relevant Representation'). Relevant Representations inform what will be considered by the Planning Inspectorate during the examination.

The period you can register to be an Interested Party and submit a Relevant Representation is between **5 November** and **11:59pm on 12 December 2025**.

- New pads for the defibrillator had been purchased and will be inserted later.

159/25 Highways and footways (including public footpaths)

a) Roads and Footpaths

- A response to our request for an update on cultivation licenses had not been received.

Action: Clerk to chase for a response.

- The temporary lights at the prison are still in use.
- The work highlighted during the walk-about with the Local Area Technician (LAT) had not been addressed.

Action: Chair to follow up with the LAT and request that the pond area is given priority as it is hoped to have the bird boxes erected before the Spring.

- Cllr Hawes had arranged for the daffodil bulbs to be planted with the help of the scouts and some residents.
- The drainage problems reported by Cllr Webster seem to have been resolved.

- Cllrs did not volunteer to be part of a FixMyStreet study by Bucks Council.
- Chair noted that following a trial in Ivinghoe, the Waddesdon Freight Zone will not be going ahead.

Cllr Webster was unable to attend the latest EFW Community Liaison Group meeting, but had asked why there was a massive heap of soil near the incinerator, but no one knew. Cllr Webster noted from the minutes that representatives from the Landfill site were not present.
